### ORDER

According to the G.O. read above, the general category of drivers in the various departments of Government has been placed in two grades – Grade I and Grade II – in the ratio of 1:4, on the basis of pool system. The Drivers in the Tourist Department are however allowed the ratio of 1:1 between the two grades.

2. Government have reviewed the position and are pleased to order that while the 1:1 ratio shall continue in the Tourist Department, the existing ratio for Drivers Grade I and Grade II in the various other departments shall be revised to 1:3

3. These orders will take effect from 1-4-1981

4. The Drivers in various departments benefited by these orders will be permitted to exercise option/re-option in respect of the higher scale provided that the right for option shall be exercised within a period of 3 months from the date of the G.O.
