ORDER

As per G.O. read above, sanction was accorded for the transfer of 2 acres of land to the Revenue Department for allotment to the Government Rubber Plantation Workers' Union, Kalady.

The Chief Conservator of Forests has in his letter read above reported that the President of the union has represented to accord sanction to remove the trees in the area on payment of single seigniorage value. He has also recommended that the tree growth over the area except teak, rosewood and ebony may be given to the Union after realising the highest rate as per G.O.MS.39/67 dated 1-12-1967 and that the teak, rosewood, ebony etc. if any may be worked down departmentally.

Sanction is accorded as a special case for the sale of tree growth except teak, rosewood and ebony in the above area to the above Union, at the seigniorage rate.

The teak, rosewood, ebony etc. will be worked down departmentally.
