Summary of Decisions and Recommendations.
Sixth Collectors Conference 10/12-5-1962.

1. The Chief Minister remarked that there should not be any occasion for surrender. The occasions for surrender should be so few that whether there is any surrender or not the result should be good. (Action- All collectors and Heads of Departments concerned with Plan).

Revenue Matters.

12. Land Acquisition.

The discussion centred round the difficulties in Land Acquisition and some departmental heads complained against delay. It was also revealed that requisitions were sent late in some cases and in some the land to be acquired was not pointed out by the Department. The Chief Minister said that it was up to the Department that required land to point out in time and land required and for the Revenue Department to find out the By. No. etc. (Action- All Heads of Departments, Revenue Department).

Miscellaneous matters.

78. National Savings – Measures to increase collection.

There was a general discussion on the subject. The Chief Minister requested the Heads of Departments to instruct their District Officers to take positive action in Co-operating with the Collectors in National Saving Scheme (Action Heads of Department).
