ORDER

The maximum period of leave without allowances that can be granted to an officer during the entire service to join the spouse is now limited to 15 years. Government are now pleased to order that the maximum period of leave without allowances that can be granted for the purpose of joining the spouse who is abroad or within the country is enhanced to 20 years.
