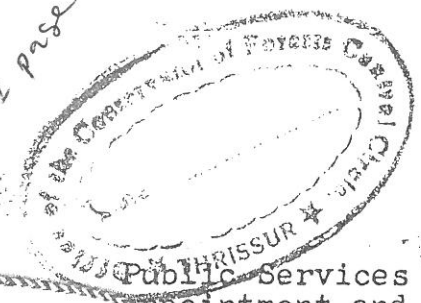

ORDER

1. In the Circulars read above instructions were issued specifying maximum period of joining time to be allowed to candidates advised by Kerala Public Service Commission to join duty by the appointing authority and the Government.

2. Recently, Government have received a number of applications from Non-resident Keralites working abroad requesting extension of joining time beyond this time limit as they are not in a position to join duty within the period of extension of time limit now allowed.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission and over ruling the advice of the Commission, Government are pleased to order that joining time to NORKAS working abroad can be granted by the Appointing Authority upto a maximum period of 6 months or till the end of one month after the expiry of the contract period with the employer, whichever is earlier subject to the condition that the seniority in such cases will be reckoned only from the date of joining duty as provided under 1st provision to Rule

Subordinate Service Rules.

4. For granting such extension of time to join duty, the appointing authority should obtain the contract entered with the foreign employer and verify it. If the contract is entered into after the receipt of appointment order, extension of time will not be granted. Extension beyond six months will not be considered on any account.


