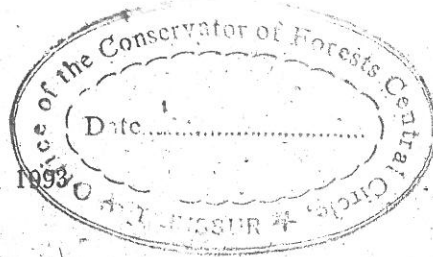
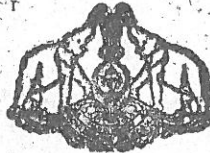

“The paying branch will credit the pensioners’ account with the net amount of the pension payable on the first working day of the same month, except in the case of pensioners and family pensioners governed by All India Services (DCRB) Rules in whose case it will be credited only on the first working day of the next month”.
