Sub:—Delegation of powers to Administrative Departments of the Secretariat to sanction Leave Without Allowances to join spouse abroad or within the country.

Ref:—1. G.O. (P) No. 209/84/Fin. dated 12-4-1984.
2. G.O. (P) No. 603/87/Fin. dated 14-7-1987.

In the G. O. first cited, guidelines for sanctioning Leave Without Allowances to Officers for the purpose of joining spouse abroad or within the country were laid down. Later, in the Government Order read as second paper above Government enhanced the maximum period of leave for such purpose from 10 to 15 years. But the power to sanction the leave had not been delegated to the Administrative Departments of the Secretariat.

Government are now pleased to order that the Administrative Departments of the Secretariat may, without previous consultation with the Finance Department, sanction Leave Without Allowances for joining spouse abroad or within the country upto a period of 15 years in accordance with the provisions of the Government Orders cited.
