ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above it was ordered that the Government of India rates of interest on General Provident Fund (Central Services) Deposits from time to time would be adopted by the State Government for all types of Provident Funds—Administered by the State Government.

In the letter read above the Government of India have announced that during the year 1995-96 accumulation at the credit of subscribers to the General Provident Fund (Central Services) and other similar funds shall continue to carry interest at the rate of 12% (Twelve per cent) per annum and that this rate would be in force during the financial year beginning on 1-4-1995.

Accordingly, Government are pleased to order that the interest at the rate of 12% (Twelve per cent) per annum will continue to be allowed on all deposits and balances at the credit of subscribers of the following Provident Funds during the financial year 1995-96.

- (2) The Contributory Provident Pension Fund (Madras)
- (3) The Contributory Provident Fund for the non-pensionable work charged Establishment of the Public Works Department.
