ORDER

As per the Government Order read Government enhanced the amount of cycle advance from Rs. 500 to Rs. 1000 and the amount of mosquito net advance from Rs. 50 to Rs. 100 with effect from 1-4-1993.

Pursuant to the above orders, Government hereby make the following amendment to Kerala Financial Code Volume I.

AMENDMENT

C. S. No. 2/94

Kerala Financial Code Volume I Article 245 (c) (iii) and 254 (3)

The first sentence of Article 245 (c) (iii) shall be substituted by the following sentence "An advance shall not exceed Rs. 1000 (Rupees One thousand) or the anticipated price of the conveyance whichever is less".

The figure "50" occurring in Article 254 (3) shall be substituted by the figure "100".

These orders will be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1-4-1993.
