ORDER

In the letter cited the Chief Engineer (General & Project) has recommended that a higher standard of knowledge in accounts matters will contribute in a large measure to the efficient working of the accounts branches of the Division Offices and that in order to give an incentive to clerks to get themselves qualified in accounts matters, it is desirable that an allowance is sanctioned to such of the clerks of his department who have passed the Account Test (Higher) as was sanctioned in the case of Typists with the Higher Qualification.

2. The Government after considering the proposal in all its aspect have decided that the grant of this special allowance should not be confined to the P.W.D staff alone, as the possession of the Account Test (Higher) qualification is as much a desideratum for those working in the accounts branches of other departments as of the P.W.D.

3. Accordingly , they are pleased to order that a special pay (Class II of Appendix IV, K.S.R .) of Rs.10per mensem will be paid to all Clerks/ Accountants including Head Clerks and Head accountants (non-Gazetted) with the Account Test (Higher) qualification working in the accounts branches of all Departments where this qualification is not obligatory.

4. This Government Order will take effect from the date of its issue.
