ORDER

In civil cases, in which Government are a party the present practice is that all cases of appeal should come before Government for sanction. This procedure causes considerable difficulties in the matter of filing appeals and revisions before Courts. Government have examined this question and are pleased to delegate powers to the District Collectors to sanction the filing of appeals and revision before all Courts in respect of Civil cases where the monetary limit is less than Rupees One lakh except administrative cases and appeals arising from sales Tax and Income tax cases. Sanction of Government will be obtained for filing appeals in all other cases.

Under section 80 of the code of civil procedure it is enough if notices to Government is served upon the Collector. There is, therefore, no objection in his filing appeals and revisions on behalf of Heads of Departments also. The District Officers in consultation with the Collectors will decide regarding the appeals in Civil suits involving a monetary limit of rupees one lakh.

The Law Department will make necessary amendments to the rule relating to duties, remuneration etc. of the Advocate General and issue instructions for the conduct of cases.
