ORDER

Government have been considering the question of allowing holidays including Sundays to the Night Watchers and arranging substitutes on such occasions. After examining the issue in detail, the following orders are issued.

1. The Night Watchers will be allowed Compensatory 'Off' for attending duty on Sundays. The benefit of Compensatory Off will be allowed to the Night Watchers without detriment to their normal duties, if they attend duty on Sundays. No additional posts will be created for this purpose.
2. In the offices where there are more than one Last Grade Servant, the Head of Office will manage the duties of the Night Watcher, when he is on Compensatory Off, by posting a last Grade servant. Such person will be granted Compensatory Off in lieu of the Night duty attended to by him.
3. In the case of offices, where there is only one Peon and one Night Watcher, the Head of Office will manage the work of the Peon, when he is on Compensatory Off in lieu of the night watch duty attended to by him, by employing a substitute if daily wages, if absolutely found essential. Daily wage hand will be appointed as Peon only.
