ORDER

The Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter read as first paper above submitted a proposal for diversion of ~~xxxxx~~ 0.950 ha. of Forest Land for Collection of Sand from Kachery Kadavu in Palappilly Range, Chalakudy Division, Thrissur district. Government of India in their letter read/a s second paper above have conveyed their approval under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of the said land.

In the above circumstances sanction is accorded for diversion of 0.950 ha. of Forest Land for sand collection adjoining to Kurumaly River at Kacheri kadavu Palappilly Range, Chalakudy Division, Thrissur District for a period of Five years subject to the following conditions.

1. The legal status of forest land shall remain ~~RM~~ unchanged.
- ii. The demarcation of forest area of river bed from where removal of sand will be allowed shall be done annually by the Forest Department.
- iii. Removal of sand will be done under the ^{over}all supervision of Forest Department and it will be restricted to the middle of the river bed after leaving one fourth of the river bed on each bank untouched.

- iv. The State Government may issue detailed guidelines for removal of Sand from forest area in the interest of Conservation of forest/ecology of the area for which the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests will furnish necessary proposal.

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (D & P) will take necessary steps to see that the above conditions are strictly adhered to and to execute a lease agreement without delay.


