ORDER

In the Government order read as Ist paper above sanction was accorded to enhance the amount to be deposited by departmental officers who intend to purchase petrol, oil and lubricants from the bunks of the Kerala State Civil Supplies Corporation to Rs.6,000/- or the amount equal to the cost of petrol, oil and lubricants that they will draw in a month, which ever is higher. - The Managing Director, Kerala State Civil Supplies Corporation in the letter read as 2nd paper above reported that huge amounts are pending realisation from various departments towards the cost of petroleum products purchased for departmental vehicles on credit basis. The prices of petrol and oil have also increase substantially. The Managing Director, Kerala State Civil Supplies Corporation has therefore suggested to enhance the amount to be deposited by departmental officers from 6000/- to Rs.15,000/- or the amount equal to 45 days fuel bill which ever is high.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to enhance the security deposit from Rs.6,000/- to Rs.10,000/- of the amount equal to 30 days of fuel bill whichever is higher.
