

Copy of Circular No.7/74 on C1-6263/74 dated. 14-2-74 from the Chief Conservator of Forests, Trivandrum to the Conservator of Forests/Divl. Forest Officers etc.

Sub :- Thinning of Teak Plantations – rejection of thinned materials regarding

In the discussion held in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests with the Vigilance Advisor, Forest and Taxes Department, Conservator of Forests (Evaluation) and Dy. Conservator of Forests (Evaluation) it has been brought to my notice that during thinning of teak plantations, a lot of thinned materials are left at site and no attempt is made to collect such materials as far as possible and dispose of them in action. Considering that these materials are useful as raw materials for industries as well as for agricultural use, it is undesirable to leave such large quantity of materials uncollected. Therefore, it has to be examined whether these thinned materials are capable of fetching at least working charges position in the country. If on same reason or other the thinned materials cannot be collected without incurring any lose the fact should be certified by the Divl. Forest officer concerned and intimated to the Conservator of Forests who will check whether such certificates are correct or not during their inspection.

The receipt of the circular should be acknowledged.
