Sub:- Linguistic Minorities - Grievances - Petitions in Kannada Language
Non-acceptance of complaints - Instructions issued.

Complaints have been received by Government that petitions written in Kannada are not being accepted and acted upon in certain offices in the backward areas. Government have already issued instructions that petitions in minority language (Tamil and Kannada) should be received and acted upon and that replies to such petitions should be given in the language of the petitions. The Heads of Departments and District Collectors are requested to give clear instructions to the officers working in linguistic minority areas that petitions in minority languages should be received and acted upon and that replies to such petitions should be given in the language of the petition.
