ORDER

While considering the lease agreement the State Government have entered into in 1958 with Messrs. Gwalior Rayon Silk Manufacturing (Weaving) Co., Ltd., for the supply of 160,000 tons of bamboos annually for the establishment of a Rayon Grade Pulp Factory at Mavoor in Kozhikode District, granting them exclusive rights and licence to fell, cut and remove bamboos from certain specified forest areas in the State, the Central Public Accounts Committee has observed, among other things, that it is essential that written records of all discussions held or decisions taken or negotiations conducted especially with regard to contracts, must-invariably be maintained by all Government representatives concerned.

Government hereby impress upon all Heads of Departments and Offices concerned that in future, the above observations of the Central Public Accounts Committee should be scrupulously followed.
