ORDER

According to the Government orders read above, inter-caste married persons are eligible for priority for appointment through the Employment Exchanges, provided one of the couple belongs to a Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Community. Children of such inter-caste married couple are also eligible for this priority, if one of the parents belongs to a Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe Community.

2. There is at present no order prescribing the authorities competent to issue inter-caste marriage certificates for the purpose of assigning the priority contemplated in the Government orders read above to the inter-caste married persons and/or their children for appointment through the Employment Exchanges.

3. Government are now pleased to order that the priority consideration to inter-caste married persons and/or their children for appointment through the Employment Exchanges, as envisaged in the Government orders cited, shall be extended only on production of a certificate from the Tahsildar concerned to the effect that the candidate satisfies the conditions laid down in para 2 (i) of the G. O. read as the second paper and is, therefore, eligible for the concession contemplated therein.
