ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above, orders were issued by government delegating the powers to heads of departments to fix the number of installments in which arrears of subscription due from compulsory subscribers to provident fund to be recovered.

2. The accountant general has brought to the notice of government that in a large number of cases, arrears of subscription to provident fund have to be recovered from the government servants who have been confirmed with retrospective effect and that there will be delay in the recovery of the arrears and administrative in convenience if the heads of departments are to fix the number of installments of recovery in each case. He has ,there for ,suggested that the question of delegating powers to heads of offices to fix the number of installments for recovery of arrears of subscription due from the incumbents working under them may be considered by government and orders issued there on.

3. In the circumstances stated by the accountant general, Government are pleased to accept his suggestion and issue orders accordingly.

4. Suitable amendments to the relevant rules will be issued in due course.
