**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 283 of the constitution of India, the Government of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Treasury Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT C.S. No.3/63.

In said rules, the existing Note to rule 278 shall be substituted by the following  
Note:-

“Note: -- In cases where the life certificate is furnished annually the Treasury Officer will require the Bank/Agent to furnish the life certificates of the pensioners whose pensioners are drawn through them, in a separate statement either to be attached to the bills for pension for December drawn in January or to be furnished in January. He will note the date of the certificate in the disbursing officer’s half of the pension payment order and file the certificates in a separate file in chronological order”.
