Sub:-Deputation to foreign service-Suspension-Subsistence
Allowance-Liability-Clarifications Issued.

At present there is no codal provision or circular instructions regarding the liability of payment of Subsistence Allowance to Government officials suspended from service while on deputation to foreign service. Government wish to clarify that the appointing authority of the Government official alone is competent to initiate and finalise disciplinary action against the Government official on foreign service. The orders terminating his deputation to foreign service will be issued simultaneously with the orders suspending him from, service. The liability to effect payment of subsistence Allowance will be with the parent department.
