**ORDER**

The Accountant General has suggested that the following revised procedure for remittance of L.I.C.recoveries effected from the Forest Department Officials may be considered and necessary orders issued in the matter. It is reported that this procedure is acceptable to the L.I.C.

2. All the Forest disbursing officers may draw a single self cheque for the entire amount of deduction towards Life Insurance Corporation Premia made from the pay and Establishment bills for a month and send the cheque together with necessary covering schedule and other supporting documents to the bank for transfer crediting the amount to the account of Life Insurance Corporation with the bank (non operating premium collection account in the case of banking treasuries). The Procedure of sending cheque by the disbursing officers direct to the Divl. Manager, L.I.C.of India may be dispensed with. In the case of non banking treasuries the present procedure of drawing & self cheque for the amount due to the L.I.C. and sending the cheque with supporting documents to the treasury for transfer creding the amount to the P.D.account of L.I.C may be continued.

3. The Chief Conservator of Forests has agreed to the revised procedure suggested by the Accountant General.

4. The Director of Treasuries has also reported that his Department has no objection to follow the above procedure suggested by the Accountant General in the case of banking and non-banking treasuries.

5. In the Circumstance Government are pleased to accept the above suggestion of the Accountant General for remittance of L.I.C. recoveries from Forest Department officials and they order accordingly. Para 3 of the G.O.read above stands modified to this extent.
