Sub:- Directions issued for destruction of Ganja cultivation in the Reserve Forests of Kerala.

On having received the information that the cultivation of Ganja has been spreading in different parts of the Reserve Forests of Kerala. The Ganja cultivation in Reserve Forests areas has to be detected without much delay. All Asst. Conservator of Forests, Divisional Forest Officers, Wild Life Wardens and Wild Life Preservation Officers are hereby directed that the Forests staff should detect all Ganja cultivation within their jurisdictions and destroy the same or bring to the notice of their superiors immediately. If not, the delinquent staff will also be prosecuted under the Narcotic Drugs and psychotropic substances Act.

Receipt of the Circular should be acknowledged and contents brought to the notice of all the staff working under your office.
