ORDER

The question of granting relaxation from age limit to provisional employees of the Government to the extent of provisional service put in by them, for the purpose of admission to the competitive tests to be conducted by the Public Service Commission for recruitment to public service has been under consideration of Government. In consultation with the Public Service Commission the Government are pleased to order that age relaxation will be granted to all provisional employees of the Government, without any discrimination as between persons whose provisional appointments were terminated for want of vacancies and persons whose provisional appointments were not so terminated, for the purpose of admission to the competitive tests to be conducted by the Public service Commission subject to the following conditions:-

1. A minimum provisional service of one year is necessary to become eligible for the Concession.
2. The maximum period of concession permissible will be 5 years.
