ORDER

In the former Travancore-Cochin State, Heads of Departments and other First Class Officers were allowed to take one peon each to their camps. If they required the services of more than one peon they had to utilize the services of peons attached to local subordinate offices. Other officers were not allowed to take peons to camps unless the journey was to hilly or out of the way places where the services of a peon were absolutely necessary. In such cases the sanction of the Head of the Department was necessary for taking peons to camps. These orders were being followed by the officers in the Travancore Cochin area till the issue of the G.P. read as second paper. In this G.P. it was ordered that there is no need for State **** Officers to take peons with them. Officers in the Travancore-Cochin area are not accordingly entitled to take peons with them while on tour.

2. The Officers in the Malabar area however continue to take peons to camps in accordance with the scale given in Annexure X to the Madras Manual of Special Pay and Allowances. The scale given in this Annexure is unduly liberal since most of the officers are permitted to take more than one peon to camp. In the letter read as third paper the Comptroller therefore suggested that the procedure in vogue in the Travancore-Cochin area may be extended to the Malabar area also.

3. The Government consider that the suggestion of the Comptroller is acceptable and accordingly direct that the order contained in the Circular read as First paper above as detailed in para I will be followed by all the officers of the State hereafter.
