ORDER

Rules 31 K.S.R. Part II provides separate rates of mileage for journeys by road in 'Special conveyance' and 'Public Conveyance' for different grades of Officers. But the term 'Special Conveyance' has not been defined in the rules. Doubts have been raised as to whether Motor Cycle can be considered as a "Special Conveyance" and whether higher rate of mileage can be allowed when journeys are performed by Motor Cycles.

Government after examining the question in all its aspects, are pleased to clarify that 'Motor Cycles' will not be considered as 'Special Conveyance' and that no higher rate of mileage will be allowed for the journeys performed by 'Motor Cycles'.
