**ORDERS**

According to Para 2 of the Orders in the G.O. read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper Government servants who retired from service on or after 15-7-1966 will be allowed to return to service, the period of break in service being treated as eligible leave. Where substitute arrangements have already been effected, the officer returning to service will be treated as supernumerary if there is no vacancy to accommodate him. Doubts have, however, been raised whether in cases where substitute arrangements were made only provisionally under rule 9 (a) rule 31 (a) of the General Rules in the Kerala and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958, such substitute arrangements should be protected by creating supernumerary posts under the orders in Para 2 of the G.O> dated 12-8-1966.

2. Where a person is appointed/promoted only provisionally expressly under rule 9 (a) 31 (a) of the General Rules in the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, the incumbent has no claim to continue in the post, irrespective of the nature of the vacancy. There is therefore no sufficient justification for the creation of a supernumerary post to accommodate the officer returning to service where substitute arrangement has been made only provisionally. Governments are, therefore, pleased to clarify that in such cases. The Persons appointed/promoted provisionally will be reverted to accommodate the officers returning to service.
