Sub: T.A claims pending for more than a year – procedure for setting the  
Claims instructions issued.

According to Article 65 of K.F.C Vol. I period of limitation in respect of T.A claims is one year from the date when the claim fell due for payment. As such arrear T.A claims more than a year old can be paid only with Government sanction and pre audit by the Accountant General.

2.Accountant General in his letter No.PAD2 /4/2-3/ 06-77/99 dated 6-7-76 has informed that the T.A claims which are pending payment beyond 3 years are not susceptible of verification in audit and hence they require Government sanction under Articles 65 of K.F.C. Vol. I for payment without verification in Audit.

3. In the circumstances all the Conservators of Forests and Divisional Forest Officers are requested to follow the above instructions while settling the arrear T.A claims.
