O R D E R

In the Government Order read as second paper above, Government issued orders revising the Travelling Allowance rates and simplifying the Travelling allowance rules, on the basis of the recommendations of the Third Kerala Pay Commission. In para 4 of the said order, it has been stipulated that Officers who actually travel in First Class/Air Conditions class and claim the fare should produce cash receipts obtained from the Railway authorities.

2.Since the Railway authorities have stopped the practice of issuing cash/receipts, Government orders that Officers who actually travel in First Class/Air Conditioned class, claim the fare, should furnish the following certificate in their Travelling Allowance Bills:-

“Certified that, I have actually traveled in the class of accommodation, for which the fare is claimed to this bill”.
