**CIRCULAR No.8/92**

Sub:- Failed Plantation – Inspection of Committee Constituted for the purpose – violation of Government orders.

It has come to the notice of the undersigned that, there were certain instances of clear violation of instructions issued by Government in G.O.(Rt) No.2224/77/AD dated 22.07.1977 by certain sub officers. In the said G.O. a committee was constituted consisting of the conservator of Forests(Territorial Circle), Conservator of Forests, Working Plan & Research Circle Divisional Forest Officer (T), Silvicultural Research Officer and working Plan Officer to inspect jointly and to draw up report in each case Plantation failed. On receipt of the report the Chief Conservator of Forests can issue necessary proceedings deleting the area from the list of Plantations under the particular species and adding the same under the new species proposed for rehabilitation. The proceedings can also deal with disciplinary action against those concerned for failure of the plantation if so recommended by the committee rehabilitating the failed area successfully.

In the above circumstances, it is informed that all Conservator of Forests/Divisional Forest Officers will follow the Government instructions strictly, and failure to obey the instructions will lead to disciplinary action against them. Receipt of the circular should be acknowledged.
