S.R.O No.....In Exercise of the powers conferred by such section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala public services act 1968(19 of 1968) read with section 3 thereof the government of Kerala hereby make the following further amendments to the special rules in respect of the Kerala Forest Subordinate Service Issued in G.O.Ms No 652/62/ public (Rules ) Department dated the 29<sup>th</sup> November 1962 and published in part I of the Kerala Gazette No I dated the 1st January 1963 namely;-

AMENDMENTS

1. Those Rules may be called the special Rules in respect of the Kerala Forest subordinate Service (Amendment)Rules,1978
2. In the special rules in respect of the Kerala Forest Subordinate Services.
  - 1) In rule I, under the heading Classes-I
    - a) For category “2 Deputy Rangers I Grade and II Grade” the following category shall be submitted, namely;”  
“2. Deputy Rangers”
    - b) For category “4 Forest Guard I Grade and II Grade “the following category shall be submitted, namely;  
“4. Forest Guards”
  - 2) In rules 2, under “CLASSES-I”
    - a) for the posts “Deputy Rangers Grade II” and “Deputy Rangers II Grade “ under category 2 in column (1) the following shall be submitted namely;  
“Deputy Rangers”
    - b) the words –“promotion of Deputy Rangers Grade II”in column (2) against category 2 shall be omitted.
    - c) For the posts “ Forest Guard I Grade” and “Forest Guard II under category 4 in column (1) the following Shall be Substituted namely;  
“Forest Guards”
    - d) the words “Promotion from Forest Guards II Grade” in column (2) against category 4 shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is part of the rules or this amendment, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

1. Formerly, there were two grades among Forest Guards and Deputy Rangers  
Consequent on the 1969 pay revision ordered in G.O.(P) 290/Fin dated 9-6-1969 the two different grades among Forest Guards and Deputy Rangers have been abolished. Hence there is only one grade each among forest Guards and Deputy Rangers.  
Accordingly the amendments are proposed.
