S R O No 653/77- In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public service Act, 1968(19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof the Government of kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Government Servants Conduct Rules 1960, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said rules to rule 46 the following explanation shall be added, namely:-

“Explanation: For the purpose of this rule “mutual benefit Society” shall Mean a society registered under a statue other than the kerala Cooperative Societies Act 1969 for the mutual benefit of its members, without any profit motive.”

Explanatory Notes

(This note is not part of the notification but is intended to indicate is to general purport)
According to rule 46 of the kerala government servants Conduct rules 1960 no Government servant shall serve or accept paid employment in any company, mutual benefit society or Cooperative Society or act as an agent. Whether paid by salary or commission to any insurance company or society. Where, how ever no remuneration is accepted , there is no objection to government servants taking part in the management of a mutual benefit society if he has first obtained the sanction of the head of his department and a certificate to the effect that the work undertaken will be performed without determine to his official duties. It has been decided to define the term “mutual benefit Society” occurring in the above rule. The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
