NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.NO.1080/79- In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the kerala public services act1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 of thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the kerala state subordinate service rules, 1958, namely;-

AMENDMENT

1. Short title and commencement;-(1) These rules may be called the kerala state and subordinate services (Amendment) Rules 1979
(2) They shall come into force at once.
2. Amendment of rule 13A- in part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services rules1958in rule 13A for clause (i) of sub rule(3) the following clause shall be substituted namely;-

“(i) double the ordinarily permissible time shall be allowed to an allotted employee for passing the test in cases where tests of a higher standard are prescribed or where no tests are prescribed in the parent state.

Explanatory Note

(This note does not form part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport)

In General Rule 13A (3) (i) as amended by G.O (P) No. 208/74/PD dated 28-8-1974 it has been provided that additional time which shall be double

that of the ordinarily permissible time will be allowed for passing new tests etc. to the employees allotted to the kerala state from the former Travancoore cochin state or the composite state of Madras in cases where tests of a higher standard are prescribed or where tests were are not prescribed in the parent state. The intension of the Government while issuing the order was to grant additional time equal to the ordinarily permitted time of two years. The High court in O.P.No 31457/74 awarded to the petitioners the benefit of six years as period of exemption from the test. A division Bench later upheld the above decision. So, in order to make the intension of the Government in clear terms it is proposed to amend to achieve the above object.
