Read:- Letter No. C5.35137/67 dated 20-1-1968 from the Chief Conservator of Forests.

ORDER

The existing practice of issue of seigniorage passes to bonafide agriculturists for collection of 20 Bamboos at a time on production of a certificate from the Tahsildar as District Agricultural Officer has created real hardship to the Agriculturists. They have to travel for miles often more than once, as these officers are touring officers, to get a certificate and then approach to the concerned Range Officer to obtain passes. In order to avoid such difficulties, Government are pleased to order that the certificates issued from the Village officers having jurisdiction of the area, are also acceptable for the issue of seigniorage passes for collection of bamboos.
