ABSTRACT**

Land – Acquisition of land for Plan schemes - Fixation of minimum turn over for Land Acquisition officers - Board's proposals - orders passed.

ORDER

Periodical reviews of Plan progress have shown that one of the major factors that impede the expeditious execution of Plan schemes, is the inordinate delay in the acquisition of lands required for them. To improve the situation Government had some time past, suggested to the Board of Revenue the fixation of minimum out turn for each L.A. Officer. The Board has now proposed that the following minimum out-turn in terms of awards may be generally fixed for each L.A. Officer for places lying within the boundaries of Malabar and Cochin areas, where survey records are in a Satisfactory condition:-

|--------------------------------|---------------------|
| 1. Main canals or main roads | 2 miles per month. |
| 2. Minor canals or minor roads | 3 miles per month. |
| 3. Lands in compact blocks. | 75 acres per month. |

In the Travancore part of the State, the Board suggests $3/4^{\text{th}}$ of the above out- turn will be adequate.

2. Government are pleased to accept the proposals of the Board of Revenue in the matter. The Board will accordingly issue instructions to all land acquisition Officers under them and insist in future on the achievement of the minimum out-turn fixed for every officer.

3. Government also expect that suitable disciplinary action will be taken by the Board of Revenue against those officers, who fail to achieve the minimum out-turn.
