NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.No.255/93 - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (I) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala, hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

RULES

(E.S.NO. 1/93)

I. Short title and commencement - (I) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Amendment) Rules, 1993.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 27th day of December, 1986.

II. Amendment of the Rules - In Part I of the Kerala Service Rules

(1) in rule 24 A for the words "ten years" in words "fifteen years" shall be substituted;

(2) in the note under rule 24 A for the words "ten year limit" the words "fifteen years limit" shall be substituted;

(3) in Appendix XII A, for Rule 6, the following rule shall be substituted, namely

"6. The maximum period of leave that may be sanctioned to an officer during his entire service shall be limited to 15 years. If the officer who has availed himself of the leave without allowance for a total period of 15 years, whether continuously or in broken periods, does not return to duty immediately on the expiry of the leave his services shall be terminated after following the procedure laid down in Kerala Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules 1960. This condition shall be incorporated in every orders sanctioning such leave;
