ORDER

According to Rule 90 (6-A) Part III, Kerala Service Rules, Family Pension is admissible to the parents (father/mother, of a deceased Government Servant if they were solely dependent on the deceased for their maintenance and have no other source of income or support. As per the G.O. read above, even where the parents have an independent source of income of less than Rs. 2,400 per annum, they are eligible to get family pension. Representations have been received to enhance the limit of the above annual income.

2. Government, after having examined the matter, are pleased to order that the income limit referred to Rule 90 [6A(i)] of Part III, K.S.Rs. will be raised to Rs. 4,800 per annum.

3. These orders will take effect from 1-1-1997. Necessary amendment to the relevant rules in Kerala Service Rules, Part III will be issued separately.
