ORDER

In the order first cited, the procedure suggested by the Government of India in their letter No. F1-33 B/57 dated 26/9/1959, in the matter of incidence of pay, allowance, leave salary, pension etc, of Government Servants transferred from one Government to another has been accepted on a mutual basis.

The Government of Uttar Pradesh in their letter cited have now conveyed their concurrence to the acceptance of the above procedure in respect of transfer/deputation from that Government to this Government and vice versa. Accordingly the Government direct that the incidence of pay leave salary, pension ect., of officers transferred from this State to the Government of Uttar Pradesh and vice versa shall be governed by the provisions contained in the Government of India's letter mentioned above.
