ORDER

The accountant General in his letter read above has put forward certain suggestions to effect strict control over reimbursement in respect of cost of medicines purchased by Government Servants.

2. Government after examing all aspects of the question in details, order as follows.
 1. Medicines for which reimbursement is allowed must have been purchased before the date of completion of treatment as shown in the essentiality certificates.
 2. The reimbursement claims which do not satisfy the conditions laid down will be dissolved and doubt full cases referred to the Vigilance Department by the Controlling Officers.
 3. Amendment to the rules will be issued separately.
