NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S.No. 40/61 dated 21-11-1961.

In part I of said rules, the following shall be added as Note 4 under rule 81 namely:-

Note 4:-- When an Officer is transferred from a vacation Department to a non-vacation Department, his period of service in the former will, for the purpose of calculation of leave, be considered to have terminated with effect from the close of the last vacation enjoyed by him. When an Officer is transferred from a non-vacation to a vacation Department his period of service in the later will be held to have commenced from the date of expiry of the last vacation previous to such transfer.
