CIRCULAR MEMORANDUM

Sub: Public Service—Treatment of Absence on 5th December 1979 as eligible leave—
Clarification Issued.

Ref: G.O.Rt. 1001/80/GAD dated 7-2-1980.

In the G.O. cited it was ordered that the absence of employees in Government service and Public Sector Undertakings in the 5th December 1979 will be adjusted against the leave to which they are eligible. A doubt has been raised whether the absence of the employees on that day can be regularized by adjusting against Casual leave, if any the employees had to their credit on that date. Government hereby clarify that the absence of the employees on 5th December 1979 can be regularized by adjusting against Casual leave if they had such leave to their credit on that date, provided that the total number of days of Casual leave availed of during 1979 including the Casual leave adjusted does not exceed the maximum limit prescribed.

2. In the Circular Memorandum No.92639/SSI/73/PD dated 5-2-1974 the Government had clarified that periods treated as 'dies-non' under Rule 14A, Kerala Service Rules, Part I would count for probation. It is hereby further clarified that the periods treated as 'die-non' subsequently regularized as leave will also be reckoned as duty for the purpose of declaration of probation.
