NOTE

In exercise of the power conferred by the provision to Art. 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S. NO. 47/61 Dated 16-12-1961.

In part of the read said rules, for the note under Rule 33 ©. The following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Note:- The appointing authority should in each case certify that the officer would have actually continued to officiate in the post but for proceeding on leave and availing himself of joining time, if any, will count for increments only to the extent it is covered by the certificate. Where no officiating arrangement is made in a leave vacancy and where the incumbent is likely to return to the same post after the expiry of his leave (in which case no joining the leave may issue such a certificate at the time of grant of leave.”
