

Circular No.786-A1/67/Law dated 31-1-1967 from Law Department, Government of Kerala

Sub:- Suits – Suits before the High Court – Information from Heads of Departments and Offices – Furnishing of – Instructions issued –

The Advocate General, Ernakulam has reported to Government that in a number of cases it has been the experience that eventhough letters have been sent to concerned officers to forward certain documents and information which are very essential for the proper conduct of the case, no document or information required has been sent to him. There are instances wherein according to the Advocate General Government have lost thecases which would have been won if the necessary documents or information when called for were furnished by the concerned officers. It is obvious that without the necessary documents or information it will be practically impossible to present the case before the Court.

This Department would therefore impress upon all Heads of Departments and all Departments of the Secretariat the necessity for sending in time the documents and information called for by the Advocate General, Ernakulam and request them to send to the Advocate General promptly the same whenever required by him in connection with the conduct of cases before the High Court.
