NOTIFICATION

S.R.O.No2/77--In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:---

C.S.No.306/76.

In Appendix VII to the said rules, in rule 1, under the heading “Section II Special Casual Leave”, after clause (ix) the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

“(x) Special Casual Leave will be granted to women Government employees having less than three children for undergoing medical termination of pregnancy. The leave shall be granted only once in their service and shall be for a period of six days including the day on which medical termination of pregnancy is conducted.
