CIRCULAR.

Sub: Allotment of priority seat on Indian Airlines Services for the Government of Kerala-Release of-Instructions-issued-
Ref:-Government circular No. 38869/A6/68/P & M dated 22nd January 1969

In order to facilitate travel by air of State Government Officers at short notice, Government of India have now allotted two priority seats on each of the following services on the understanding that the above seats would automatically revert for commercial sale if not utilised 48 hours before the scheduled departure of the air craft.

1C-501	Trivandrum-Cochin
1C-502	Cochin-Trivandrum
1C-533	Trivandrum-Cochin
1C-534	Cochin-Trivandrum

The allocation of the priority seats at Trivandrum will be controlled by Shri.M. Mohankumar, I.A.S., Deputy Secretary to Government, Public Department and at cochin by the District Collector, Ernakulam. The priority seats which are available in other flights and which were hitherto under the control of the joint Secretary, Home and Public as per the Government circular cited will also be controlled by the Deputy Secretary to Government, Public Department instead of the Joint Secretary, Home and Public.

The Officers requiring the priority seats are requested to forward their requisitions sufficiently early to Government and to the District Collector, Ernakulam in respective cases as and when necessity arises.
