ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above, Government have issued detailed rules for the grant of grade promotions with effect from 1-7-1979. In the G.O. second cited, it has been clarified that a lower Division Clerk who has not passed Manual of Office procedure Test will also be eligible for higher grade on completion of 13 years of qualifying service in the entry grade and that the pay of the employee on the date of his promotion will be fixed under Rule 28A of Kerala Service Rules Part I, taking into account the pay he actually draws on the date of his promotion, in the lower post and the next increment shall be allowed only after passed the prescribed Manual of Office Procedure test as per the normal rules.

2. According to Rule 13 (B) of Kerala Subordinate Service Rules, certain officers who are nearing the age of retirement or who have completed a specified number of years of service, are eligible for permanent exemption from passing obligatory tests. Government have not considered the provision in the said rule of Kerala Subordinate Service Rules, while issuing the G.O. second cited. After examining the case in detail, Government are now pleased to order that those who are eligible for permanent exemption from passing obligatory departmental tests as per Rule 13 (B) of Kerala Subordinate Service Rules, will be eligible for increments in the higher grade provided they are otherwise eligible.

3. The G.O. second cited shall stand modified to the extent indicated above.

4. These orders shall take effect from 1-7-1979.
