ORDER

For releasing pension and death cum retirement gratuity, last pay certificate has to be furnished to the Accountant General. Sometimes, the issue of last pay certificate is delayed on account of the procedural delay in the encashment of the last pay bill. Consequently, settlement of pension claims is also put off. The Government consider that such delay could be avoided and accordingly in consultation with the Accountant General the Government are pleased to order that in cases where no outstanding dues are recoverable from retired or deceased Officer and only payment are due to them, the last pay certificate showing the date up to which payments have already been made the date of termination of service and the rate of pay issued on which arrears are due will be issued. The Accountant General will authorize payment of pension and death-cum-retirement gratuity on the basis of the last pay certificate so issued.
