ORDER

The benefit of the ad hoc increase in pension sanctioned in 1974 as per the G.O. read above was allowed only to those who retired before 1-7-1973. The intention was that this benefit would accrue to all the pensioners whose commenced from 1-7-1973 i.e., who did get any benefit of the pay revision sanctioned with effect from 1-7-1973. The Accountant General has in his letter cited. Stated that prior to 5-4-1974 the date of retirement of an employee was on the forenoon of the date immediately following the date on which he attained 55 years of age and so all the employees who retired on the forenoon of 1st July 1973 are not eligible for the benefit of *ad hoc* increase sanctioned in August 1974. But that day is a non-working day as far as the employee is concerned and pension commences from that date. He has therefore suggested that to make them eligible for the benefit of the *ad hoc* increase. Specific relaxation of the rules is required.

2. Governments have examined the question in all its aspects and are of the view that, there is no necessity to relax any rules in this regard. However to remove the doubts, it is clarified that the benefit of *ad hoc* increase sanctioned in G.O.(P)261/74/Fin.dated 17-8-1974 will be admissible also to those employees who attained the age of 55 years on 30-6-1973 and retired with effect from the forenoon of 1st July 1973 and whose pension commenced with effect from 1-7-1973.
