Sub:- Foreign Training-- Nomination of candidates-- Procedure to be followed –
Instructions--Reiterated.

Ref:- Government Circular No. 5504/CI/82/ P&ARD dated 23-6-1982.

As per the Government Circular read above, all Heads of Department have been informed that no officer or Heads of Department had been delegated with powers to send nomination for foreign training directly to Government of India and proposals for making nominations of officers for training abroad should be sent in the Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department.

It has now come to the notice of Government that, despite the above instructions, certain Public Sector Undertaking sends nominations for training abroad, direct to Government of India and seek ratification of action.

Government with to make it clear once again that nominations for training abroad should invariably be routed through Government in the P & ARD . And that violation of this instruction will be very seriously viewed. In future, Government will not grant expose to facto approval to such nominations and will not support them on any account.
