Sub:- Waiving of recovery of cost of training of State Government employees who are appointed to an All India or Central Service.

A copy of the government of India letter referred to above is herewith communicated to all Heads of Departments and Departments of Secretariat for information. As a reciprocal arrangement it has been decided to waive recovery of expenditure incurred by this Government on their employees who are appointed to an All India or a Central Service and therefore where recoveries are being effected in accordance with the government Memorandum referred to above they may be suspended immediately. The above reciprocal arrangement would not apply to p[ersons holding technical posts.

In suppression of this Ministry's No 27/32/61-AIS(I), dated the 8th January, 1965, I am directed to say that, on re-consideration, it has been decided to waive recovery of expenditure incurred by the Government of India on their employees appointed to the State- Services. I am to request that, as a reciprocal arrangement, the State Government may also waive recovery of expenditure incurred by them on their employees who are appointed to an All India or a Central Service.

2. The above reciprocal arrangement would not apply to persons holding technical posts.

3. Where recoveries are being effected by the State government in accordance with the letter referred to above, the recoveries may be suspended immediately.
